\*<sup>2</sup> The number of finals run for the various categories will be dependent on the number of entries. Where a final is run for an individual category placings will be determined based on finals results. For all other categories placings will be determined based on qualification results.

\*<sup>3</sup> If only one qualification squad is required or finals for an earlier category are not required start times will be moved earlier.

\*<sup>4</sup> Final will only be run if there are 3 or more competitors. Finals may be consolidated in order to give athletes experience shooting finals but in these case awards will be based on qualification scores. If a final is not run placings will be determined by qualification results.

**Medal Presentations will be held as soon possible after the finalisation of each match. Athletes are to ensure they present for medal presentations in appropriate attire.**

### Entry & Competition Conditions

- **Entries close:** 5th April, 2026.
- **Practice:** Available on arrival day at the competitor's own cost (\$20.00).
- **Squadding & Finals:** Times and locations may vary depending on entry numbers and scheduling constraints.
- **Late Entries:** Accepted only if bays are available and must be accompanied by a **Late Fee of \$20.00 per match. No later entries will be accepted after 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026.**
- **Entry Fee:** Open Entry Fee includes entry into grades and all other categories.
- **Squadding Requests:** Requests will only be considered for shared equipment. Approval is subject to entry numbers, range capacity, and officials' availability. All requests must be noted on the Entry Form.
- **Concurrent Events:** Efforts will be made to provide adequate time between squads for athletes competing in concurrent events; however, this cannot be guaranteed.
- **Entry Submission:** Only entries submitted with a completed Entry Form will be accepted.
- **Rules & Regulations:** The Nationals will be conducted in accordance with **ISSF, WSPS, and TRA Australian Supplementary Rules.**
- **Membership Requirement:** All competitors must be members of **TRA** or a recognised international shooting federation.
- **Program Changes:** **TRV** and the **TRA Board** reserve the right to amend the program if necessary.
- **Licensing Requirements:** Current **Membership Registration Cards** and **Shooters Licences** must be presented at registration.
- **Range Register:** Must be signed daily by all athletes, officials, and any other persons entering the range.
- **Squadding Information:** Will be provided as soon as possible after entries close.
- **Equipment Provided:** Shooting mats will be available on the range.
- **Organising committee reverse the right to alter program and structure of competition based on 2026 rule changes from the ISSF.**

<b>WSPS R3/R5/VIP:</b>	Eligibility: R3 & R5 & VIP Athletes Open R3/R5/VIP Champion – Based on results of R3/R5/VIP Final R3 Champion – Based on qualification results. R5 Champion - Based on qualification results. VIP Champion - Based on qualification results.
<b>10m Air Rifle Open</b>	Eligibility: Men, Women, R1, R2, VIS Athletes Open Champion – Based on results of Final. Junior Champion – Based on qualification results. Grade A, B, C, D – Based on qualification results.
<b>10m Supported Air Rifle</b>	Eligibility: All as per TRA Auflage Supported Rifle Rules Open Champion – Based on qualification results. Junior Champion – Based on qualification results.
<b>Air Rifle Mixed Teams</b>	Eligibility: Men, Women, R1, R2, VIS Athletes. Teams to be nominated by States. Multiple Teams per State are permitted. Same gender teams are permitted. If a State has odd number of athletes every attempt will be made find an athlete from another State to shoot with them.
<b>50m Prone &amp; R6 &amp; R9</b>	Eligibility: Men, Women, R6 Athletes Open Champion – Based on qualification results – ISSF & WSPS. Men's Champion – Based on qualification results – ISSF Athletes. Women's Champion – Based on qualification results – ISSF Athletes. Junior Champion – Based on qualification results – ISSF Athletes. WSPS R6 Champion – Based on qualification results – WSPS Athletes. WSPS R9 Champion – Based on qualification results – WSPS Athletes. Grade A, B, C, D – Based on qualification results.
<b>10m Air Rifle Men</b>	Eligibility: as per ISSF Rules Men's Champion – Based on finals results.
<b>10m Air Rifle Women</b>	Eligibility: as per ISSF Rules Women's Champion – Based on finals results.
<b>WSPS R1 &amp; R2 &amp; VIS</b>	Eligibility: as per WSPS Rules WSPS R1/R2/VIS Champion – Based on finals results.
<b>TRA Benchrest 50 metres</b>	Eligibility: All as per TRA Supplementary Rules Open Champion – Based on qualification results. Junior Champion – Based on qualification results. Grade A, B, C – Based on qualification results.
<b>WSPS R4</b>	Eligibility: as per WSPS Rules WSPS R4 Champion – Based on finals results.

### **Entries and squadding advice:**

**Entries are requested by no later than 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2026. Late entries will only be accepted if space permits and late fee (\$20 per event is paid).**

**Please note,** start times for each squad, may vary depending on the number of squads required.

### **Firearms Licences, transport, storage and range safety:**

The licence provided by your state will be recognised in Victoria.

**Trophies, Awards and Medals:**

All awards, medals, certificates & trophies will be presented according with Nationals Manual.

**Medal Presentations:**

Presentations will be conducted as soon as possible after the final results being posted in each event.

**Gradings:**

**Entry into graded matches.** All shooters will be automatically entered into grade matches for events where graded categories applied. If no grade is selected on the entry form they will be entered as 'A' Grade.

All 10m & 50m events will be shot on Electronic Scoring Targets.


